The Home Builders Institute (HBI) is giving secondary schools across the country the chance to apply for the Schools to Skills Grant. This grant initiative, which is funded by The Home Depot Foundation (THDF), allows schools to launch or enhance career technical education programs using HBI's nationally recognized Pre-Apprenticeship Certificate Training (PACT) curriculum. HBI will work closely with your school administrators and instructors to implement a skilled trades training program and provide industry-recognized certifications to middle and high school students.

Submit an application by Monday, December 16th to adopt the PACT Program at your school or school system.

- ▶ Develop hands-on technical skills via projects
- ▶ Learn how to succeed in a career in the building industry
- ▶ Earn industry-recognized credentials in up to 9 Trade Specialty areas
- ▶ Offer alternatives to a four-year college track, which can be costly
- ▶ Provide students with additional career options
