## Military and Veteran Programs FREE Home Maintenance & Building Trades Training

Training is DOD SkillBridge approved.  
4-week program. Earn 3 certifications!

The class objectives include an **OSHA 10 Certificate**, an **American Red Cross CPR/AED/First Aid certificate**, and **Pre-Apprenticeship Certificate Training (PACT)**. The PACT certificate is 25% classroom/LMS modules and 75% hands-on training, which covers **building trades and building maintenance**. The following training is covered: **Carpentry** (flooring, roofing, framing, trim, windows & doors, & siding), **Electrical**, **Landscaping**, **Masonry**, **Painting**, **Plumbing**, **Construction Math**, and **Tools & Materials**

## **Military and Veteran Program – Crestview Home Maintenance & Building Trades Training**

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HBI offers tuition-free construction career education and training with a focus on professional development, mentoring, and ongoing support for transitioning military members and their spouses/dependents, as well as veterans and their spouses/dependents.

To qualify, you must be a **Florida resident, 17+ years old, meet one of the following criteria and provide documentation:**

### **Separating Active Duty within 180 Days of Separation:**

- A copy of your DD2648 or DD2958 signed by you and the Transition Counselor,
- Florida identification card, Florida driver's license, or documentation demonstrating identity,
- Florida identification card, Florida driver's license, or documentation demonstrating Florida residency, and
- Social Security card, or documentation demonstrating authorization to work in the United States

### **Veteran:**

- A copy of your DD214 with a discharge or release from service under conditions other than dishonorable, Florida driver's license "Veteran" special designation, or Florida identification card with the "Veteran" special designation
- Florida identification card, Florida driver's license, or documentation demonstrating identity,
- Your Florida identification card, Florida driver's license, or documentation demonstrating Florida residency, and
- Social Security card or documentation demonstrating authorization to work in the United States

### **Spouse of Active-Duty Personnel:**

- A copy of your United States Department of Defense/Uniformed Services ID card,
- Your Florida identification card, Florida driver's license, or documentation demonstrating identity,
- Your Florida identification card, Florida driver's license, or documentation demonstrating Florida residency,
- Your Social Security card or documentation demonstrating authorization to work in the United States, and
- Your marriage license demonstrating proof of marital status to Active-Duty Personnel.

**Child of Active-Duty Personnel:**

- A copy of your United States Department of Defense/Uniformed Services ID card,
- Your Florida identification card, Florida driver's license, or documentation demonstrating identity,
- Your Florida identification card, Florida driver's license, or documentation demonstrating Florida residency,
- Your Social Security card or documentation demonstrating authorization to work in the United States, and
- Your birth certificate/adoption documentation demonstrating proof of relationship to Active-Duty Personnel.

**Spouse or Child of a Veteran:**

- A copy of your spouse's DD214 with a discharge or release from service under conditions other than dishonorable, Florida driver's license "Veteran" special designation, or Florida identification card with the "Veteran" special designation
- Your Florida identification card, Florida driver's license, or documentation demonstrating identity,
- Your Florida identification card, Florida driver's license, or documentation demonstrating Florida residency,
- Your Social Security card or documentation demonstrating authorization to work in the United States, and
- Your marriage license demonstrating proof of marital status to Veteran.

**Spouse or Child of a Veteran:**

- A copy of your parent's DD214 with a discharge or release from service under conditions other than dishonorable, Florida driver's license "Veteran" special designation, or Florida identification card with the "Veteran" special designation
- Your Florida identification card, Florida driver's license, or documentation demonstrating identity,
- Your Florida identification card, Florida driver's license, or documentation demonstrating Florida residency,
- Your Social Security card or documentation demonstrating authorization to work in the United States, and
- Your birth certificate/adoption documentation demonstrating proof of relationship to Veteran.
