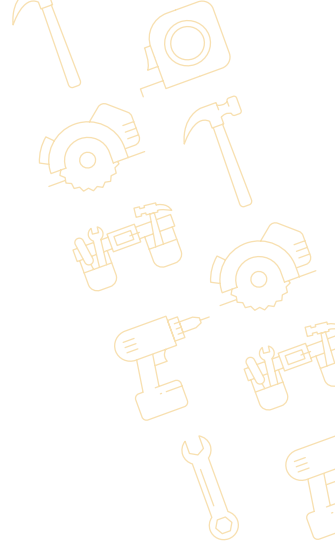

## Schools to Skills

Invest in HBI's Schools to Skills Program to expose students to the trades and build students foundation to a successful career path!

HBI's Schools to Skills grant program provides funding to secondary schools to implement HBI's nationally recognized pre-apprenticeship curriculum (PACT). PACT is suited for school-based instruction and offers 9 trades vetted by subject matter experts. PACT guarantees students will learn residential construction focused skills, receive hands-on training, and master the knowledge needed to begin a career in the building trades.

Schools to Skills contributions may be designated to support training in a specific state or support the overall impact this national grant program.

## Student Success Fund

Invest in HBI's Student Success Fund to give students comprehensive support during their every step towards a career in construction!

HBI's Student Success Fund helps students from our job training programs overcome challenges so they can secure gainful employment. The Student Success Fund provides direct support to help students eliminate barriers in order to obtain or maintain employment. Examples of direct support have included purchase of work tools, transportation assistance, as well as securing housing. Student Success Funds may also be used to enhance the student in-program experience. Examples of program enhancements have included the purchase of classroom tablets, as well as van rentals to support field trips to real-world work sites.

Student Success Fund Priority will be given to graduates and programs in the state of your choosing.

## HBI Academies

Invest in HBI's Academies to help tackle the industries labor shortage and give students a path to a successful career in the trades!

HBI's Academies offer tuition free programs to anyone 18 years or older who are interested in learning the construction trades. Academy funding will be allocated to continue to grow the program in major markets to bridge the gap between the skilled labor shortage and workforce development. HBI's goal is to launch 20 Academies across the country within the next 5 years. At full capacity, the Academies will serve 8,000-9,000 individuals per year, across all locations.
